You may borrow two books for up to two weeks. If you want them for longer let the librarians know and they will renew them.

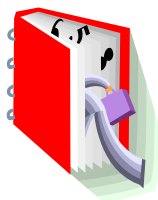
Books must be issued and returned by the library staff. Always use the Library Counter.

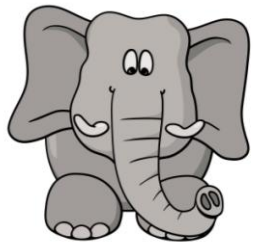

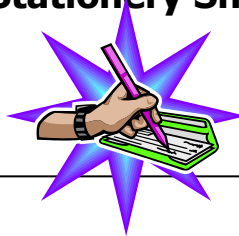
