Already very popular with local teenagers, Alveston Juniors badminton club launches its new section - Wacky Racquets - for younger players, in January.

Alveston Juniors already offers affordable coaching in the sport to players aged from 10 to 17 and is now beginning a weekly session at Kineton High School aimed roughly at the 8 to 11 age group. The club is currently being assessed for Silver Clubmark status - which gives parents the comfort of knowing their children are in a safe and secure environment

Each week, players will learn the FUNdamentals of sport - a qualified coach will supervise a variety of games and exercises which will improve the children's agility, balance and co-ordination, whilst introducing basic racquet skills with mini badminton. Whilst we will be looking for future badminton stars, the skills they'll develop will improve their ability in all sports

Participants will love the variety of activities, especially the "Chocolate Challenge"!

Sessions will be 90 minutes long and will cost £4 - or pay in advance for five sessions and get one free (£20 for six sessions) and don't worry if you miss a week as you only have to pay for the sessions your child attends.

Also included in this cost is a free club polo shirt too! Once your child has attended eight sessions they are given their very own club top to show they belong. Each child is given their own record card to track their progress and achievements.
